

# Fire Marshal Training Course

**ALL workplaces** are required **BY LAW** to have sufficient number of Fire Marshals to deal with Fire emergencies fast and effectively

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 came into force in October 2006 and with it the requirement to have a strategy to evacuate all the occupants within a building. The fire service cannot be relied upon to assist with evacuation. As such, businesses are recognising the importance of having fully trained fire wardens as part of their emergency evacuation strategy. Having fire wardens has shown to be the quickest, most effective way to evacuate a building. It is also seen as a pro-active approach – fire wardens can be used to identify fire hazards and dangers before a fire

## Course Syllabus

This course provides a clear understanding of the responsibilities, duties and role of a Fire Warden conforming to all the requirements of the Regulatory Reform Order (Fire) 2005; delegates will also be trained to identify and rectify problem areas, with the end result being a safer workplace.

The evacuation of all personnel within a building should be clear and contained in staff guidelines. They should be regularly rehearsed as a part of every evacuation or fire drill and we cover this extensively within the course.
